Job Summary

The Junior Camp Counsellor will work closely with the Camp Counsellors and Camp Manager to plan, coordinate and deliver online activities to campers ensuring their participation, engagement and attention in the virtual classroom.

The Junior Camp Counsellor will have skills that include working in group settings, with conflicting priorities, creating project plans, and communicating effectively.

The Junior Camp Counsellor should feel comfortable working online and be able to exercise leadership skills to help build character in children and youth, conduct research and offer support in the development of youth-based programs.

General Responsibilities

- Proactively identify and solve problems for campers and volunteers in a timely manner
- Assist in the planning and delivery of camp activities and special events for campers 6 to 13 years of age
- In collaboration with the camp team, organize and disseminate weekly program schedules for all activities to all camp members and RootsCS Manager, Programs & Volunteers
- Meet daily with the camp team to discuss and evaluate the program in terms of camper concerns, activities, determine what is working well, what needs refinement and develop strategies for improvement
- Be accessible to other camp staff, campers, and their parents

- Be respectful of and interact professionally with staff, volunteers, campers, and their parents
- Adhere to and support camp policies and procedures as detailed in the summer camp manual, and help ensure that all camp staff, volunteers and campers do the same
- Report major issues to Camp Manager or RootsCS Manager, Programs & Volunteers
- Provide counsellors with support, ideas, and ongoing feedback
- Work with camp staff to submit a final report detailing the progress and success of the summer camp program, making recommendations for next season and any outline any other constructive comments

- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations
