- Lead the design, creation and implementation of a comprehensive organization-wide evaluation strategy that would help increase the efficacy of programs, services and processes
- Assess the impact of programs, especially those that were implemented during the pandemic, highlight positive outcomes, and identify and make recommendations on areas for improvement
- Through consultation with program teams, develop evaluation and monitoring systems at program level with clear monitoring, knowledge mobilization and reporting measures
- Provide objective evaluation of programs, services, processes and activities to ensure they are meeting their stated goals
- Work with program coordinators and managers to identify gaps and potential modifications to maximize the effectiveness of the program or service; develop and/or revise logic models for each program as well as develop required measurement tools
- Provide insights to management to help guide decision-making with regards to budgeting, staffing and other operational issues that may be impacting the success of a program or service
- Present monthly evaluation results to the management team and assist program coordinators in producing targeted and effective outcome-based reporting
- In collaboration with management and program teams, track community needs and trends, and conduct research to further analyze and understand trends
- Use data to create knowledge that can be shared to raise awareness of identified trends and community needs
